



Directions to the six Seasons Holidays home resorts

LAUGHARNE PARK COUNTRY CLUB

Laugharne, Carmarthenshire Telephone 01994 427332

Laugharne Park Country Club is idyllically situated overlooking Dylan Thomas' world-famous 'Milkwood', his famous boathouse and the beautiful Taf Estuary. Simply head west on the M4 towards Carmarthen, joining the A40 to the town of St. Clears. Take the A4066 signposted Laugharne (4 miles) and Pendine. In the main street of the picturesque village, turn left at the Mariners Inn and the entrance to Laugharne Park is 250 yards ahead.

Conveniently located less than 90 minutes from the Severn Bridge and a comfortable drive for anyone in Wales or the border towns.

CLOWANCE ESTATE AND COUNTRY CLUB

Praze-an-Beeble, Camborne, Cornwall Telephone 01209 831111

Clowance is very easily reached from all parts of the country by car via the M5 then the A30 to Camborne. Take the Camborne West exit, the second Camborne turning. At the top of the slip road turn left to the roundabout turning left again into Camborne. Follow this road for 1 1/2 miles to the second mini island and turn right, follow this road for about 500 yards to the next mini island opposite the police station, turn right again onto the road that is signposted B3303 Praze-an-Beeble 2 1/2 miles. Follow this road through the village of Praze-an-Peeble, the Clowance Estate is then located half a mile along on the right hand side.

BURN PARK

Bude, Cornwall Telephone 01288 355037

Burn Park Country Club is an award winning holiday estate in a lovely rural setting, as featured in the press and television.

From Exeter: take the Okehampton by-pass (A30) off the M5, until you reach the A386 sign-posted Bude. Follow the signs to Bude, taking the A3079 to Holsworthy, where you should join the A3072 to Bude. Follow the road through to Stratton to the A39 junction. Turn right at the staggered crossroads, then immediately left (marked 'no through road'). The entrance to Burn Park is approximately 200 yards on your left.

From Plymouth: follow signs to Callington, Launceston, and Bude until you reach Stratton, where you should follow the directions above.

Easy access from the M5 and A30 for the whole of the West Country. Both Exeter and Plymouth are within 90 minutes drive.

WHITBARROW VILLAGE COUNTRY CLUB

Leave the M6 motorway at Junction 40. Take the A66 towards Keswick for 7 miles. Look for the Sportsman's Inn on the right. Turn right into the road signposted Whitbarrow and Hutton Roof. The lane takes you to the rear of the Sportsman's Inn and then you will see a left hand turn signposted Whitbarrow Village. Go past the caravan park and turn right, then you will see the entrance to the resort on your right hand side.

Less than 15 minutes due west of the M6, just 90 minutes from Newcastle and within 2 1/2 hours of major cities such as Leeds and Manchester.

SEASONS AT BRUNSTON CASTLE

Ayrshire, Scotland Telephone 01465 811589

From Carlisle, follow the M6 motorway north, which continues onto the A74 to junction 12. Turn onto the A70, follow this road to Ayr, the A77 to Maybole.

If coming from Glasgow or Edinburgh, take the M8, then join the A77 to Kilmarnock/Prestwick Airport. Follow the signs for the M77 to Ayr, which becomes the A77 to Ayr, where you should continue on the A77 to Stranraer until you reach Maybole.

At Maybole, turn left at Cassillis Hotel onto the B7023 to Crosshill Arms and then onto the B741 to Dailly. On reaching Dailly, take the first right. Drive through the village, bearing right at the end of the village and over a bridge. Then take the first left onto the golf course road and follow the road alongside the golf course. Turn right at Brunston Avenue, and the reception is situated inside the Leisure Centre on the left hand side at the top of the hill.

Only 50 minutes from Glasgow city centre and within 2 hours of Edinburgh and other major towns in the central belt.

SEASONS AT KNOCKTOPHER ABBEY

The resort is in Knocktopher village on the main N10 Kilkenny to Waterford Road. The entrance is opposite Knocktopher church.

From Dublin: Take the N25 towards Waterford/Newcross. Look for the sign to Kilkenny R700. This will take you to Thomas Town. When you come in to Thomas take the N9 left to Waterford. After about 5 miles you will see a sign for Knocktopher. Turn right, then turn left at the T junction in Knocktopher and you will see the house on your right hand side.

Within 90 minutes of Dublin and less than an hour from the eastern and southern coasts.
